### AIA West Jersey Community Service Day: Tree Plantings in Camden

On Saturday morning, May 16, members of AIA West Jersey joined local residents and other volunteers in Camden to plant twenty shade trees along Berkley Street in the Lanning Square neighborhood. This Community Service Day supports the New Jersey Tree Foundation with its Urban Airshed Reforestation Program (UARP), which has planted over 3,200 trees in Camden since 2002.

According to Jessica Franzini, the UARP Coordinator, each tree has been adopted by a child in the neighborhood who will take care of it and watch it grow.

The planting of trees helps mitigate air and water pollution in Camden's urban environment and provides a safer, healthier environment for the residents, who are most affected by industrial pollutants.
